


















## 2024 Flowers and plants available From St. Paul Lutheran Church




Flower		<p><b>Alyssum Snow Crystal</b> Extra-large white florets on dwarf plants give this early flowering variety an extra showy appearance.</p> <p>Spreads 12 – 14 inches</p>
Flower		<p><b>Begonia, Dragon Wing Red</b> Angelwing begonia. Vigorous and heat tolerant. Has shiny green foliage and red flowers. Part to full shade. Height: 14 – 18 " Spread: 15 - 18" spacing 15 - 18" inches.</p>
flower		<p><b>Castor beans</b> are a fun tropical looking plant that will grow 5 – 6 feet tall. These have broad leaves with a purple hues and interesting red fruit. Not edible.</p>



Flower		<p><b>Coleus</b> Color Blaze Rediculous, grows 24 – 40 inches tall. Can be grown in shade to sun. Deadheading is not necessary. Heat tolerant. Excellent for containers or for landscape.</p>
Flower		<p><b>Coleus, ColorBlaze® Strawberry Drop.</b> Can be grown in sun or shade. Gets about 20 inches tall and as wide. To keep foliage in top shape, pinch off the blooms as they appear if you wish. Can be overwintered (indoors).</p>
Flower	<p><b>Geranium, Maverick F1</b> This uniform flowering series features multiple stems and large blooms. We have Red and White flowering plants.</p> <p>Prefers full sun. Grows 14 – 16 inches tall.</p>	
Flower		<p><b>Impatiens, double; Rockapulco® Coral Reef.</b> Best for shade or part shade. Grows 10 – 20 inches tall. Space 12 inches apart for a border. Deadheading isn't necessary but removing spent blooms isn't harmful. These are easy to care for, provide them with a shady location, give them a bit of fertilizer and don't let them dry out too much.</p>
Flower		<p><b>Ipomoea Marguerite (Sweet Potato Vine)</b> Will produce brilliant lime-green to bright yellow-green foliage, a great contrasting color! Ipomoea's are heavy feeders, so they benefit greatly from regular fertilizer feedings. Water regularly if in container. Full Sun to Part Sun (3+ hours).</p>






Flower		<p><b>Ipomoea Sweet Caroline Raven (Sweet Potato Vine)</b> Grows deep purple, nearly black five-lobed leaves that spread, vine, and add great contrast color. Its colors will come to life through early Spring, Summer, and Fall, right up until the first frost. Ipomoea is desired most for its vivid foliage, rapid vigorous growth, heat tolerance, and trailing/vining growth habit for landscape, beds, baskets, and containers. They mound to about 6-12”, then spread up to 30 inches.</p>
Flower		<p><b>Millet, Purple ornamental</b> Can be used as a spike in potted plants or point of interest in flower bed or yard. Color develops deepest in full sun. Grows to 5 foot tall.</p>
Flower		<p><b>NuMex Easter</b> 2014 AAS Winner. Ornamental pepper. Loaded with pepper fruits in fun colors. drought, humidity and rain.</p> <p>Grows to only: 6" tall.</p>
Flower		<p><b>Petunia Surprise Yellowstone Forever.</b> Has a rich shade of yellow. Plants are perfect for large baskets. This petunia blooms early and is considered semi trailing.</p>
Flower		<p><b>Petunia DuraBloom Red</b> These are a new variety of petunias and were bred to be vigorous and bloom like crazy no matter the weather. They bloom from spring though summer. Should withstand heat and humidity. Great for landscape or containers.</p>
Flower		<p><b>Petunia SuperCal® Premium Petchoa Purple Dawn.</b> This is a cross between Calibrachoa and Petunia. The plant flowers profusely and the blooms are smaller than a petunia. It wants full sun. Grows 14 – 24 inches tall and spread 12-20 inches. Petchoa are vigorous all-weather performers that can stand up to cold and heat. Great for baskets or containers.</p>





Flower		<p><b>Petunia Supertunia®</b> Supertunia petunias are vigorous with slightly mounded habits that function as both fillers and spillers in containers. Will bloom continuously until frost without deadheading. They are also excellent landscape plants, best suited to be placed near the front of beds. They have medium to large sized flowers. FANCY, but not fussy. Attracts Butterflies and Hummingbirds  Height to 12” and 18 – 24” spread.  Available Color Vista Bubblegum,</p>
Flower		<p><b>PETUNIA Sweetunia Black Satin</b> A black petunia that is semi-upright. It grows eight inches tall and 15 inches wide. It has a trailing habit. This plant will need the flowers to be pinched off. Attracts hummingbirds. Can be used for containers or for borders. Needs full sun.</p>
Flower	<p><b>Sedum, Lemon Coral</b> Beautifully textured succulent with spiky yellow-green foliage. This tough-as-nails annual is heat &amp; drought tolerant once established &amp; deer resistant. It is the perfect filler for hanging baskets, combination containers, &amp; landscapes. Its beautiful foliage pairs well with other vigorous, sun-loving varieties. 3-10 inches tall and spreads 10-14 inches at maturity. Plant in part to full sun (4+ hours daily).</p>	
Flower		<p><b>Torenia Blue Moon Torenia</b> (commonly called <i>Wishbone Flower</i>) is an annual flower originally from Asia. Features showy purple tubular flowers with yellow throats and a lavender flare along the stems from late spring to mid fall. Its small fragrant pointy leaves remain green in color throughout the season. Space 8 inches apart, height 6 inches and spread of 12 inches. Grows well in Partial Shade to Shade.</p>

Flower		<p><b>Viola Sorbet XP Autumn Mix.</b> Flowers Bold colors that bloom early tolerant of frost. Violas have smaller flowers than pansies.</p>
flower		<p><b>Zinnia AAS Mix. Profusion Color Mix</b> Highly prolific bloomers produce masses of 2" semi-double flowers. Grow to 18" tall. Perform exceptionally well in both containers and landscapes, due to their combined tolerance for both cool and hot, humid conditions. In addition, they have excellent disease tolerance. Mixed colors</p>
Flower	<p><b>Combination container Trixi Lip Sync</b></p>  <p>Put in a sunny location.</p>	<p>For sun. Combination of pink, yellow and blue flowers for a sunny location. With care they will last the entire season. Height:14 - 16" Spread:16 - 19"</p> 
flower		<p><b>Combination planter.</b> For shade, This proven Winners collection includes dark sweet potato vine, strawberry drop coleus and double coral colored impatiens. It is designed for part or full shade.</p>





Herb		<p><b>Basil 'Dolce Fresca' vigorous Genovese type</b> Classic basil flavor for pesto. Bred for season-long performance and continual harvests, Genovese is a well-branched yet tidy plant that performs well in field or container plantings. Pinch back to help the branch out and to make new leaves.</p>
Herb		<p><b>Cilantro Calypso</b> The special ingredient in salsa.</p>
Herb		<p><b>Flat Leaf Parsley (Italien)</b> Specially developed for use as fresh seasoning, this parsley offers large, bright green leaves that you can cut as needed all season long on compact plants.</p>





		<p><b>Broccoli Emerald Crown</b> A Sakata variety specifically bred for high quality and high yield crown cuts. Very uniform, tight heads with beads that are blue green. Medium sized head.</p>
	<p><b>Cabbage Stonehead Hybrid</b> A popular, early hybrid for home garden or market. Solid, slow to burst heads..</p>	





Vegetable		<p><b>Cantaloupe, Ambrosia</b> A winner in taste tests. Ambrosia is recognized as one of the best tasting melons for the East. Its 4 to 4-1/2 lb., round fruit have a tan color with a medium net and non-distinct sutures. The peach colored flesh has a wonderful sweet flavor, making it a good roadside melon.</p>
Vegetable		<p><b>Cucumber Tasty Green Slicing</b> type offers high yields of 8-9" long, slender dark green fruits. These burpless cucumbers are crisp, juicy and have a wonderful mild, sweet flavor. Each plant has male and female flowers. Very popular for the home garden.</p>
Vegetable		<p><b>Cucumber Saladmore Bush Cucumber.</b> 55 Days. Compact vines spread only 24 inches, yet produce an average of 10 to 12 fruits per plant. Harvest small, dark green fruits for pickles or allow them to fully mature, 7 to 8", for fresh use. Crisp flesh has a mild, sweet flavor. Keep fruits picked to extend the harvest season. Perfect for growing in containers or smaller gardens where space is limited. Resistant to CMV, Scab, Anthracnose and Powdery Mildew.</p>
vegetable		<p><b>Cucumber Bush Pickle</b> Compact plant produces high yields of shorter flavorful green cucumbers. Great for making crisp pickles. Saves space in gardens and containers</p>
vegetable		<p><b>Eggplant, Night Shadow</b> Classic Large plant bears traditional teardrop-shaped fruit that holds quality into a very large size. Very glossy and attractive and holds color well. Widely-adapted, vigorous plant.</p>




vegetable		<p><b>Eggplant Hansel All America Selections</b> winner! Hansel's slim, elongated miniature fruit are tender, smooth, and non-bitter. Harvest can begin about 55 days from transplant, when fruit are 2 to 3" long. The clusters of fruit can be harvested a few days later at 4 to 5" length without loss of fruit quality. The 18" plants yield good quantities of these glossy dark-purple fruit.</p>
vegetable		<p><b>Pepper, Sweet Banana Pepper</b> A hybrid sweet banana pepper that is vigorous, disease resistant and sets big yields on upright, compact plants. The sweet, tapered fruit ripen from light green to red.</p>
vegetable		<p><b>Pepper, Jalapeno M</b> An improved thick-walled jalapeno pepper with the same fiery hot pungency, this uniform strain does quite well in northern plantings. The 3-1/2" x 1" tapered, sausage-shaped fruit are smooth and deep green turning red. Heavy yields are produced on upright plants.</p>
vegetable		<p><b>Pepper, Giant Marconi</b> This All America Selections winner produces a long tapered fruit that is ideal for the Italian fryer type market. Giant Marconi peppers have a wonderful, sweet taste when it matures to red. The 8" long x 3" wide fruit. Is great for roasting or grilling. Ripens deep green to red.</p>



vegetable		<p><b>Pepper Sweet, Red Knight</b> Early maturing. Big, blocky fruits are early to turn red. Stronger disease resistance than King Arthur and a more compact, open plant. Flavor is fruity and sweet. Widely adapted.</p>
vegetable		<p><b>Pepper, Early Sunstation</b> A great early pepper, Early Sunstation produces large, smooth fruit that mature from dark green to bright golden-yellow at full maturity. The blocky fruit have thick walls and a sweet taste when allowed to ripen to yellow. Intermediate resistance to BLS adds to the appeal of this early beauty.</p>
		<p><b>Bishops Hat Pepper</b> The bishop's crown pepper is a spicy little chili pepper distinctively shaped like a bishop's crown, hence the name. It brings respectable heat and is great for cooking.</p>
Vegetable		<p><b>Super Verde Hybrid Tomatillo.</b> 75 day. Extra large fruits are firm, weigh approximately 2 1/2 ounces each, have strong healthy husks, an attractive green color and an above average shelf life. Sturdy plants have excellent vigor, cover and fruit set. Features better uniformity, a higher yield potential and an extended harvest window - all improvements over comparable varieties. Fruits are a lovely golden-yellow, weigh 1/2 oz., and possess thin skins - remarkable, considering its wonderful crack resistance, even in heavy rains. Heavy early cropper. Very vigorous. <b>I Hybrid</b>	<b>58</b>		<p data-bbox="784 743 1472 1031"><b>Tomato, cherry – Candyland</b> This 2016 AAS National Winner has a much more manageable and compact indeterminate plant than other currants do. Its .5" round deep red fruit are produced on long trusses of multiple fruit. The branched trusses are easily accessible for easy harvest of its tiny, very sweet fruit. Matures early and continues producing until frost. Requires staking.</p>
<b>I</b>	<b>90-100</b>		<p data-bbox="784 1073 1472 1178"><b>Tomato, Heirloom. Brandywine.</b> Pennsylvania Amish heirloom dating to 1885. Regular leaves and delicious, scarlet-red fruit.</p>
<b>I</b>	<b>74</b>		<p data-bbox="784 1398 1472 1608"><b>Tomato, paste - Amish Paste</b> A long-time favorite heirloom plum. Large for a sauce tomato, Amish Paste's slightly irregular plum-to strawberry shaped fruits avg. 8-12 oz. with excellent flavor. These meaty tomatoes are good in salads and great for processing. Indeterminate.</p>

<b>D</b>	<b>75</b>		<p><b>Tomato, paste - Roma</b> Most well-known paste-type tomato. Dozens of 2- to 3-ounce, pear-shaped bright red fruits arise on these determinate plants. Great for pastes and sauces, Roma offers a meaty flavor and very few seeds.</p>
<b>I hybrid</b>	<b>75</b>		<p><b>Tomato, table - Better Boy hybrid</b> A spectacular, midseason variety with plump, juicy, deep red tomatoes that often weigh more than one pound. And once they arrive they just keep on coming! Fruits are extremely flavorful, with flesh that's juicy, yet firm. Heavy foliage protects fruits from sun-scald. A highly adaptable variety that thrives in nearly any climate. Demonstrates excellent disease resistance.</p>
<b>I Hybrid</b>	<b>73</b>		<p><b>Tomato, table - Big Beef Hybrid Tomato</b> Smooth fruits are globe-shaped, weighing 9 to 16 oz. A good choice to try in virtually any climate, readily overcoming adverse growing conditions and adapting easily to different environments. Coupled with old-fashioned, rich flavor, it features bred-in hybrid qualities - colossal fruit size and yield, uniformity and a full spectrum of disease resistance. Indeterminate.</p>
<b>D hybrid</b>	<b>54</b>		<p><b>Tomato, table – Bush Early Girl</b> 54 days This "determinate sister" to popular Early Girl (delivers the same desirable qualities in a compact, patio-sized variety: an extreme earliness and huge yields of firm, meaty, flavorful fruits that are larger than Early Girl - a full 4" in diameter.</p>

semi-D hybrid	70		<p><b>Tomato, table - Celebrity</b> 70 days from setting out transplants. Determinate. Celebrity is a superior all-around tomato with such fantastic disease resistance you can put away the sprays and soaps for good! These determinate plants are exceptionally strong, bearing masses of smooth, round, bright red tomatoes. Weighing about 8 ounces, they're very uniform (no green shoulders here!) and resistant to cracking.</p>
I hybrid	70		<p><b>Tomato, table - Jet Star</b> 72 Days. Jet Star produces big yields of large, clean fruit, quite free of cracks and scars, in the second early season. Globe-shaped fruit with bright, attractive color inside and out have a very pleasant flavor. Sturdy, indeterminate vines grow vigorously, producing heavily on stakes or on the ground. Jet Star is a low acid tomato. If you wish to can Jet Star, please add lemon juice.</p>
D hybrid	71		<p><b>Tomato, Yellow table - Carolina Gold Hybrid</b> The Carolina Gold tomato features a unique golden-yellow colored fruit that is low in acid and uniform ripening. This variety is very adaptable, and its strong, determinate plant produces mostly extra-large and large fruit throughout the season. To maximize yield potential, stake culture is recommended. Resistant to Verticillium wilt and Fusarium wilt</p>
