


<p>Snapdragon Floral Showers Mix F1</p>		<p>This dwarf, early-blooming series flowers uniformly and under short day conditions. The basal-branching plants perform well in packs, 4" pots and the garden. Annual</p>
<p>Snapdragon, Toquilla sunrise</p>		<p>A punchy mix of bright colors makes this an exciting focal point. The vibrant pinks and yellows are pleasing to the eye. Dark green, almost black, foliage. Bushy plants do not exceed 18 inches tall.</p>
<p>Torenia, Kauai rose</p>		
<p>Zinnia Zahara Mix</p>		<p>Zahara varieties offer larger flowers compared to the Profusion Series (approximately 20%) and more colors. Mid-height plants are well branched with an equal spread and are heat, drought and disease tolerant. The full, bushy plants are covered with vibrant flowers that make a marvelous statement in annual gardens and in containers throughout the summer. Color: Formula mixture of Zinnia Zahara colors</p>
<p>Herb Dill Fernleaf</p>	<p>Annual. The dwarf, 18" plants produce abundant blue-green foliage and are slow to bolt. Fernleaf is an excellent choice for pack and container sales, or it can be sold as a "baby bunched" dill.</p>	

Herb Thyme Winter	Perennial. <i>Thymus vulgaris</i> . Oval, grey-green, aromatic leaves grow on upright, shrubby, 8 to 12" plants. Thyme is used fresh or dried to flavor meats and vegetables.
Tomato Aunt Ruby's German Green	Large delicious green tomato. Each fruit can grow to a pound! Said to have brilliant neon-green flesh and a sweet fruity flavor. Described as tastier than most red tomatoes.
Tomato Big Beef F1	This All America Selections winner produces large, 10-12 oz. fruit on indeterminate plants. The Big Beef tomato is rated high for quality and flavor, and it does best when staked or caged. Intermediate resistance to V (race 1), F (races 1 & 2), <i>Alternaria</i> stem canker, gray leaf spot, RN, and tomato mosaic virus.
tomato Black Vernissage	Black tomato loaded with flavor. Produces 2 oz tomatoes. Rich tasting.
Tomato Brad's Atomic Grape	 <p>A Favorite tomato! 75 days. Elongated, large cherries in clusters. The color (and flavor!) is a full-blown assault on the senses—lavender and purple stripes, turning to technicolor olive-green, red, and brown/blue stripes when fully ripe. Really wild! Fruits hold well on the vine or off, making this amazing variety a good candidate for market growers. Olive green interior is blushed with red when dead-ripe. Tomato Bush Early Girl F1	Compact determinate plants produce good early yields of 6-7 oz. fruit. Because of its space-saving plant and early maturity, Bush Early Girl tomatoes make a nice addition to your bedding plant offering. Celebrity offers home garden eating quality in a commercial hybrid.</p>
<p>Tomato Jet Star F1</p>		<p>Fresh market and plant sales favorite. Jet Star tomato plants produce big yields of large, clean fruit, quite free of cracks and scars, in the second early season. Globe-shaped fruit with bright, attractive color inside and out have a pleasant flavor. Sturdy, indeterminate tomato vines grow vigorously, producing heavily on stakes or on the ground. Tell your customers: Jet Star is a low acid tomato. Add lemon juice when canning.</p>
<p>Tomato Mountain Merit F1</p>		<p>Mountain Merit is a medium-large, 8-10 oz. tomato produced on a determinate plant that has a high level of resistance to late blight. It has good adaptability, deep red colored, firm fruit and also offers intermediate resistance to early blight and Nematodes. Resistance to TSWV will also make this an appealing variety for Southern growers to use.</p>
<p>Tomato Pony Express F1</p>		<p>An early, determinate saladette tomato. Early, concentrated sets have been noted on Pony Express tomatoes in grower's fields throughout the Northeast. Its determinate plant produces excellent yields of large saladette type fruit that are elongated in shape and have a dark red color. Growers have been impressed with its earliness, size and yields when compared to other varieties of this type. Pony Express tomatoes have an excellent disease package that includes resistance to Fusarium wilt (races 1,2,3), Verticillium wilt (race 1), Root Knot Nematode, Bacterial speck and Tomato mosaic virus helps to ensure that you'll be able to produce a high quality crop of tomatoes.</p>
<p>Tomato Riesentraube</p>		<p><i>"giant bunch of grapes"</i>. Old German heirloom tomato first offered in mid 1800's. Sweet red fruit grow in clusters. Each tomato is only an ounce.</p>

<p>Tomato Sugar Plum F1</p>	<p>The Sugar Plum tomato has been rated the best tasting grape tomato in taste tests. Its indeterminate plant sets heavy yields of 1" grape-shaped fruit that have a rich red color. The firm fruit has a pleasing texture and its sweetness generate repeat sales from your customers. The fruit form in long clusters, which allows for an easy harvest.</p>
<p>Broccoli Diplomat F1</p>	<p>Attractive blue-green heads with a small bead size make Diplomat broccoli an excellent choice for the roadside and fresh market trade. Diplomat broccoli matures in 75 days and has shown good heat and cold tolerance, and it produces uniform semi-domed heads. Intermediate resistance to downy mildew. Patent 5945582.</p>

Bravo cabbage, a rugged hybrid, has performed well from the Deep South in winter to the North in summer. The large, round cabbage heads are uniform and a beautiful blue-green color. Use close spacing (10-12 in.) for market and wide spacing (18-24") for sauerkraut.</p> </div> </div>
<p>Cucumber Regal F1</p>	<p>Our customers' first choice. We offer an early, high-yielding gynocious hybrid pickle with a longer, slimmer shape for chips, spears and whole packing. The dark green, stippled fruit are tapered and can be either hand or machine harvested in the North or South. Regal has been popular with Harris customers for years and widely used by processors.</p>
<p>Cucumber, Burpless 26 F1</p>	<div style="display: flex; align-items: center;">  <div data-bbox="816 1182 1263 1430"> <p>8 to 10" fruit. The smooth, dark green fruit are thin-skinned and with no bitterness.</p> </div> </div>

<p>Pepper Early Sunsation F1</p>		<p>A great early pepper, Early Sunsation produces large, smooth fruit that mature from dark green to bright golden-yellow at full maturity. The blocky fruit have thick walls and a sweet taste when allowed to ripen to yellow. Intermediate resistance to BLS adds to the appeal of this early beauty.</p>
<p>Pepper Giant Marconi F1</p>		<p>This All America Selections winner produces a long tapered fruit that is ideal for the Italian fryer type market. Giant Marconi peppers have a wonderful, sweet taste when it matures to red. The 8" long x 3" wide fruit tapers, and matures earlier than other marconi types and is great for roasting or grilling. Ripens deep green to red.</p>
<p>Pepper Lady Bell F1</p>		<p>This hybrid pepper has been a consistent performer in the Northeast. The rich green fruit that ripen red have a uniform deep bell shape with 3-4 lobes and medium-thick walls. Lady Bell is prolific, even in cooler weather and is one of the dependable producers of sweet peppers we know. It is popular for pepper plant sales as well as fresh market use.</p>
<p>Pepper Sweet Banana</p>		<p>Long pointed yellow fruit make this variety look like a hot pepper, but its flesh is sweet. Sweet Banana is about 6" long, pointed, and light yellow turning to bright red. This pepper has always been popular for frying and pickling.</p>
